**RESOLUTION 2014-1**

"Resolution Changing the Number of Poll Workers"

**WHEREAS,** the municipality of the Town of Clinton in Vernon County of the State of Wisconsin and

**WHEREAS,** Section 7.32 of the Wisconsin Statutes allows a municipal governing body to reduce the required number of election officials at a polling place to no less than 3, and the town board has determined that it would be advantageous to the town to have only as many election officials on duty as are needed for a given election, and


**WHEREAS,** the town desires to employ a sufficient number of poll workers to provide convenient balloting during elections,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Town Board of the Town of Clinton in Vernon County Wisconsin declares there may be a minimum of 3 election officials on duty at the polling location at each election. At the discretion of the town clerk, the number of election officials may be increased for any election. However, the number of election officials working at any given election shall be an odd number.
