

Resolution 2 – 2021

Resolution of Town Board to Propose Exceeding Levy Limit

Whereas, the State of Wisconsin has adopted levy limits on town, village, city and county levies for 2021 and thereafter under s. 66.0602 of Wisconsin Statutes;

Whereas, s.66.0602 of Wisconsin Statutes limits the allowable local levy for 2021 to a percentage increase of no more than the greater of (a) 0% of the 2020 payable 2021 adjusted actual levy as calculated under the state's levy limit law* or (b) a percentage equal to the percent change in equalized value due to net new construction; which for the Town of Clinton is 2.645 percent;

Whereas, the Town Board of the Town of Clinton, Vernon County believes that for the 2021 tax levy (collected in 2022) it is in the town's best interest to exceed the state levy limit as described above by a greater percentage than the 2.645 percent;

Whereas, the Town of Clinton 2020 payable 2021 adjusted actual levy is \$158,793; and further whereas the state law would limit the increase to \$4,129 for an allowable town tax levy increase of \$5,566 before adjustments, for 2021 collected in 2022.

Now therefore the Town Board of the Town of Clinton, Vernon County does hereby resolve and order as follows:

1. The Town Board supports an increase in the Town Tax Levy for 2021 that will exceed the state levy limit.
2. The Town Board directs that the question of increasing the town tax levy for 2021 (to be collected in 2022) by 53.42 percent, which would increase the town levy by \$84,821 for a total town tax levy of \$258,317 shall be placed on the agenda for the Special Town Meeting to be held on November 17th 2021.
