- *Remove labels from tin cans.
- *Place mixed papers and paper board in paper bags or loose into your town's container.
(Please do not put paper into plastic bags)



Household Hazardous Waste

Vernon County does **not** accept hazardous waste at any of its locations or at the county facility during regular course of business. County residents are able to take hazardous waste to the La Crosse County Hazardous Waste Program throughout the year for a fee or bring the material to our Semi-Annual Clean Sweep Events.
