

AN ORDINANCE CREATING TITLE 5 CHAPTER 2 SEC. 5-2-10

FIRE PROTECTION AND PREVENTION CODE, PUBLIC SAFETY, OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF CLINTON

The Board of Trustees of the Township of Clinton do ordain as follows:

1. Creating Chapter 2 SEC. 2 of Title 5. Title 5 of the Township of Clinton Code of Ordinances, entitled "Public Safety," is hereby created a SEC.5-2-10 in Chapter 2 entitled "INSPECTIONS."
2. Text of SEC.5-2-10. The text of SEC.5-2-10, Fire Protection and Prevention, shall be as follows:

CHAPTER 2

Fire Prevention and Protection Code

ARTICLE A

General Provisions; Adoption of Codes

SEC. 5-2-10 INSPECTIONS.

- (a) The Fire Chief or his designee shall have authority to inspect all premises on a periodic basis, at least once per year, and shall enforce the applicable laws and ordinances.
- (b) The Chief of the Fire Department, or any subordinate designated by him, may, at all reasonable hours, enter any building or premises within his jurisdiction for the purpose of making any inspection, or investigation which, under the provisions of this code, he or they may deem necessary to be made. Private dwellings shall not be entered without the consent or permission of an adult occupant.
- (c) FREQUENCY OF INSPECTION. The Chief of the Fire Department, or his authorized designee, shall inspect, or cause to be inspected, at least once each calendar year, provided the interval between those inspections does not exceed 15 months, the buildings and structures as identified in (b) above. The Fire Chief or his designee, may require more frequent inspections of any building or structure referenced in (b) above as deemed necessary.
