## **Update 10-year Plan:**

• Change #2 to: Pay increases for one (1) Town Patrolman to be minimum of Cost of Living increase, reviewed yearly. Change #3 to: \$20,000 for Evenstad bridge. Change #4 to: \$20,000 for Bloomingdale bridge. Change #5 to: \$1.8 million, \$30,000 per mile. Change #6 to: \$50,000, \$5,000 per year. Change #7 add: 2010 red truck. Change #9 to: \$37,371 per year for 10 years for financing. Strike #10 and #11: completed. #12 becomes #10, change: \$21,448 one-time payment. Add new #11: to consider #20,000/year for 10 years for upgrades to Cashton Fire Building.
